

# Salt Lake County Election Statistics

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Why is there such a disparity between what happens at convention and what happens at primary? These disparities were not due to signature-gathering or write-in candidates.

## **Example #1: US Congressional District 1. Andrew Badger Blake Moore Race, 2022**

### **SLCo GOP 2022 Primary**

Andrew Badger	1754	16.7%
Blake Moore	6624	63.1%
Tina Cannon	2116	20.2%
<b>Totals</b>	<b>10494</b>	<b>100%</b>

## Example #2: US Congressional District 3. Chris Herrod John Curtis Race, 2022

### SLCo GOP 2022 Nominating SLCo GOP 2022 Primary Convention

Candidate	Votes	Percent
Chris Herrod	558	54.7%
John Curtis	462	45.3%
Tina Cannon	eliminated	
Chris Herrod	9856	27%
John Curtis	26577	73%
Totals	36433	100%
